

Violinist **Kathrin ten Hagen** played her debut with the Nürnberger Symphoniker at the age of 14. Since then, she has appeared as a soloist with the Deutsche Symphonieorchester Berlin, the Hamburger Symphoniker, the Jenaer Philharmoniker, Moscow Symphony Orchestra, State Chamber Orchestra of the Republic of Belarus, USC Symphony Orchestra, Arcata Stuttgart, and the Kammersymphonie Leipzig, among others. She was invited to play at the Festspiele Mecklenburg Vorpommern, the Holland International Music Sessions, the Zermatt-Festival Switzerland and at the Yellow Barn Festival in Vermont/ USA. Her concerts were broadcasted by Deutschland Radio, WDR 3 and Bayern 4 Klassik.

Kathrin ten Hagen has won first prizes at the Donald Portnoy International Violin Competition in Augusta, the California Young Artists Competition in San Diego, the International Wolfgang Marschner Competition and the Ibolyka-Gyarfas Violin Competition of Berlin's Music Academies.

Ms. ten Hagen worked as Donald Weilerstein's assistant at the New England Conservatory in Boston. She was also invited to teach at the Young Artist Program of the Yellow Barn Festival USA in 2009 and 2010, as well as at the Euro Music Festal Halle in 2015 and 2016. Since 2011 she has been on faculty at the Hochschule für Musik und Theater "Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy" Leipzig.
